The point of a painting workshop is to learn something new, challenge oneself and have fun! So paint, don't worry! Bring the supplies you have (don't buy anything new) and be prepared to challenge yourself while trying something different. The supply list is what I will be using but please feel free to work with your own choice of colours, brushes etc. Please bring photos you would like to try painting. I will have lots to choose from as well.

Supply List

Acrylic paint – I will be using titanium white, cadmium yellow light (or hansa yellow opaque), quinacridone red (or cad red med), UM blue. I may use dioxazine purple, burnt sienna, phthalo green or whatever else falls into my paint box.

Brushes – I will be using flats

Grounds – 3 black gessoed surfaces (square or rectangular, no larger than 12 x 12in or 11X14 in) I may use cheap watercolor taped to a hardboard and then black gessoed or cheap canvasboards from the \$ store. You are not going to be painting masterpieces; you are here to have fun!

Chalk for sketching on black surface

Normal paint supplies(paper towels, rags, water holder, posca pens etc.)
